

Motorcycle Cleansing Guide

A motorcycle has the potential to be used by multiple persons, both Team Members and Customers. In turn this increases the potential of the motorcycle harbouring an increased level of bacteria.

COVID 19 can transmit to surfaces that are touched by infected persons. This can then transmit to other individuals that touch the surface.

To protect both Team Members and customers when operating motorcycles, the following sanitisation steps must be followed whenever:

- Using a customer's motorcycle
- Handing the motorcycle back to a customer
- Getting onto a motorcycle when you weren't the last person to use it

1) Using an isopropyl alcohol-based sanitiser and micro-fibre cloth wipe the following key exterior touch points of the vehicle:



- Handle bars
- Riders seat
- Passenger seat
- Fuel tank and cap

- Starter button / Keys
- Twist handle controls
- Brake handle controls
- Lighting switches
- Other control switches
- Mirrors



Prior to using a motorcycle and following use of a motorcycle you must wash your hands. This helps stop the transmission of bacteria to and from the motorcycle.
