

Point of Sale and Sale of Merchandising - COVID 19 Controls

In relation to COVID 19 Point of Sale items and the sale of merchandise poses a risk due to the potentially high frequency of different people touching the items leaving the virus in waiting for the next person to touch it and transfer it.

Sale of Merchandising

In the event that a site is intended to sell merchandise to customers (merchandising including but not limited to; clothing, vehicle accessories, valet products) the following COVID 19 controls will need to be followed:

- 1. Make the merchandising visible enough to limit the amount of touching required. For example; don't place a certain item of clothing behind another that requires the customer to move an item out of the way
- 2. Customers are not permitted to try items of clothing on
- 3. Any items returned will need quarantining for 72hours before being made available for sale again
- 4. Any hard surfaces used to display merchandising should be sanitised with surface sanitiser on a frequent basis

Point of Sale Items

Similar to merchandising; point of sale items such as leaflets, brochures, colour scheme selectors etc can be returned to circulation. Its important that any hard surfaces used to display the point-of-sale items are sanitised on a regular basis with surface sanitiser.
